
or our first Attorney at Work "Apple at Law Users Survey," conducted in the fall of 2015, we collaborated with the organizers of MILOfest (the Annual Macs-in-Law-Offices Event) to learn how lawyers are using Apple products: Are their firms 100 percent Mac, or are they the sole users? Is Mac use a solo practice thing, or are Macs encroaching on BigLaw? Which Mac models do lawyers use? What about iPhones and the Apple Watch? And, of course we want to know what apps Mac law firms are using.










Of the 299 respondents who use iPhones, 60% use the iPhone 6 or 6s models.




